




Origami Shark Craft

Color and cut out your shark (square) and fins. Place your shark face down and fold all four corners into the middle (see diagram). Turn over and fold each new corner into the middle. Fold in half (with the shark's eyes on the outside). Insert your fingers and thumb into the flaps and pinch together to make your shark. Attach fins to sides and top. *You may wish to glue sides of head/mouth together.*



Dorsal fin. Color and cut out. Fold on dotted lines and attach flaps to top of shark.



Pectoral fins. Color and cut out. Fold on dotted line and attach flaps to sides of shark.
